## Outreach and Recruitment

### **WBBZ-TV INTERNSHIP PROGRAM:**

WBBZ is committed to giving college students a hands-on internship experience that includes working on location station productions, social media promotion, event coordination and general assignments.

1) WBBZ-TV hosted a 3rd year student at SUNY New Paltz, as an intern at WBBZ-TV for the summer semester of 2022.

This intern earned college credits for their work as a production & promotion intern working from mid-May through mid-August 2022.

They worked in assisting the WBBZ team with various productions, learning to operate studio cameras, the operation of the TelePrompTer, responding to viewer inquiries, posting to social media, assisting with mobile production shoots in the field, observing the editing process, and working station promotions at two events.

### **WBBZ Outreach**
